Dear Neighbor Letter – Fill in your name, the date by which orders should be returned to you, as well as a note indicating whether the kits will be delivered by you or should be picked up at your home. Make the appropriate number of copies needed and distribute them to your neighbors in your area of responsibility (see Luminary Order Form). Extra copies of the “Dear Neighbor” letter are available at the Ronald McDonald House. *Be sure to place the letters in your neighbors’ front doors rather than in mailboxes in order to comply with the U.S. Postal Service rules regulating circulars without postage.*

Luminary Order Form – After collecting your neighbors’ orders and money, complete the pink form for your records. Bring the money and completed yellow form (including your email address) to the Distribution Center from December 4-10. Pre-ordering is not necessary.

Distribution Center:

Location – 339 Witt Street in Winston-Salem (Witt Street is off Knollwood Street, one block from Stratford Road). The Center is in the back of the Habitat for Humanity headquarters.

Dates – Sunday, December 4 – Saturday, December 10
Monday – Saturday, 10 am-4 pm; Sunday, 1 pm-4 pm
